My fellow DPP members and I hope that through positive engagement and public involvement that Armagh can become an even safer place in the coming year.

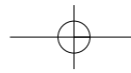
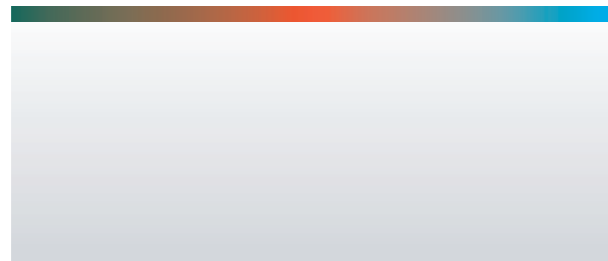

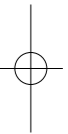

### Notes

- (1) Targets will be measured against performance achieved during 2009/10.
- (2) Non-domestic violence with injury crimes are defined as offences of murder, manslaughter, infanticide, child destruction, attempted murder, causing death/GBH by dangerous driving /aggravated vehicle taking, wounding/GBH with intent, firearms/explosives offences endangering life, administering poison, wounding/GBH and AOABH - which do not have a domestic motivation attributed to them. Domestic abuse is an under-reported crime. Measures will be taken by the police service to increase and encourage reporting of domestic violence with injury by providing victims with the confidence to make a report to police. Police will continue to seek to improve clearance rates for domestic related violent crime.
- (3) 3 year target of 15% reduction between 2008 and 2011.
- (4) Vehicle Crime - "vehicle crime includes theft from motor vehicles and theft / unauthorised taking of motor vehicles."
