1. The number of burglaries and the detection rate for burglary.	1.1 To reduce the number of burglaries by 3%. (1)

2. The percentage of people who perceive the level of antisocial behaviour to be high.	2.1 To establish a Baseline of the number of incidents of antisocial behaviour specifically nuisance during Quarter 1 and achieve a reduction in subsequent quarters. (2)

PROFESSIONAL POLICING – DELIVERING AN EXCELLENT SERVICE

3. The percentage of people who agree police and other agencies are dealing with the antisocial behaviour and crime issues that matter in local areas.	3.1 To report on initiatives being undertaken with partnership agencies twice a year to the DPP.

5. The number of adults and children killed or seriously injured on the road.	5.1 To demonstrate the PSNI's contribution to reducing the number of adults and children killed or seriously injured on the road.
6. The level of violence with injury.	6.1 To reduce the number of non-domestic violence with injury crimes by 3%. (1)
7. The percentage of recorded crimes detected.	To increase the detection rate for serious crime: 7.1 Violence with injury crimes by 3 percentage points. (1) 7.2 Domestic violence with injury crimes by 5 percentage points. (1) 7.3 Hate crime by 3 percentage points. (1)
