The law says YOU are responsible for getting clear consent before sex. If you don't, it could be seen as rape. Rapists face prison and are listed on the Sex Offenders Register.

Ask yourself:

- Has your partner drunk a lot of alcohol?
If they have, their judgement will be affected and they will not be able to make a decision about consent.

Ask your partner:

- “Are you sure?”
- It is your responsibility to ensure you have consent before sex. Make sure you are clear about your partner's response.

Be S*M*A*R*T

- * **S**ex without consent is rape.
- * **M**ake sure you ask and get a clear response.
- * **A**lcohol affects your and your partner's judgement.
- * **R**ape convictions last forever.
- * **T**ake NO for an answer.
