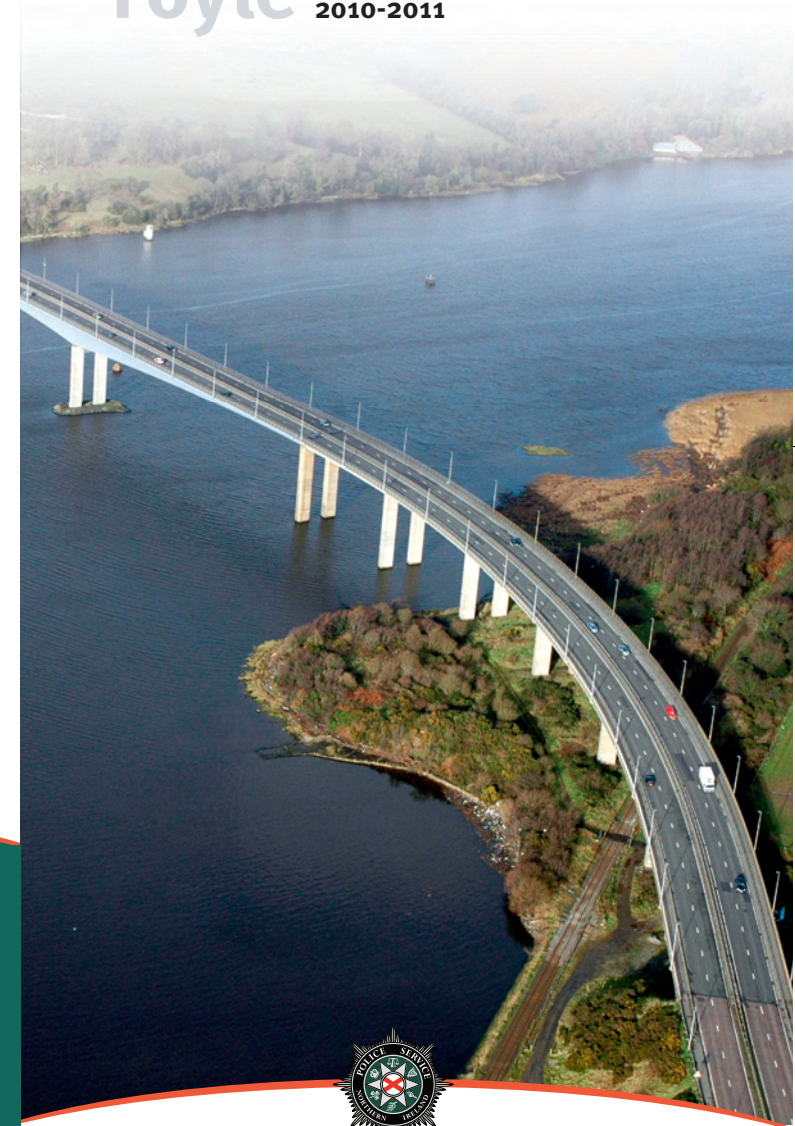

#### Notes

- (1) Targets will be measured against performance achieved during 2009/10.
- (2) Violence with injury crimes include, offences against the person, sexual offences and robbery.
- (3) Detection rate – persons charged, reported for prosecution or persons who receive a formal caution.
- (4) Target measured against 2007/08 data. This is consistent with Key Performance Indicator 3 of the Northern Ireland Office's Public Service Agreement, 'Make Communities Safer'.
- (5) These targets will be measured by way of public survey conducted by Derry Policing Partnership.
