PERSONAL POLICING – DEALING WITH LOCAL CONCERNS	
1. The number of burglaries.	1.1 To reduce the number of domestic burglaries by 5%.
2. The number of incidents of antisocial behaviour.	2.1 To establish a Baseline of the number of antisocial behaviour incidents during Quarter 1 and achieve a reduction in subsequent quarters with the aim of achieving a 5% reduction for the year.
	2.2 To report the number of confirmed incidents of underage drinking and referrals made via the Youth Diversion Officer.
3. The availability of controlled drugs and the ability of drug dealers to engage in criminal activity.	3.1 To increase the number of drugs seizures.
4. The number of formal meetings held between the DPP and local Neighbourhood Teams.	4.1 Representatives of Neighbourhood Policing teams to meet formally with DPP at least twice a year.
PROTECTIVE POLICING – TACKLING SERIOUS HARM	
5. The level of violence with injury.	5.1 To reduce the number of non-domestic violence with injury crimes by 5%.
	5.2 To ensure that the alleged offender is arrested in at least 75% of domestic violence with injury crimes.
	5.3 To report the number of all violence with injury crimes to the DPP on a quarterly basis.
6. The number of adults and children killed or seriously injured on the roads.	6.1 To increase the number of detections for dangerous driving offences by 5% as part of the overall strategy to reduce the numbers of adults and children killed and seriously injured on the roads.
