Effective policing is the community and local officers working together to make our neighbourhoods safer for everyone.

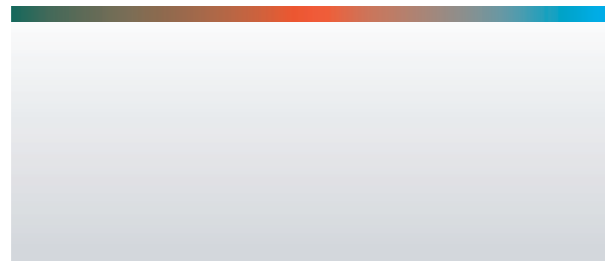
In consultation with the District Policing Partnership a number of areas have been identified as priorities for 2010/11 including burglary, drugs, road safety and antisocial behaviour.

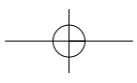
