* Sanction clearances refer to clearances where a 'sanction' is taken against the accused person as opposed to clearances that result in 'no further police action'. Sanction clearances include the following clearance types; charge/summons, TIC, adult caution, adult informed warning, juvenile restorative caution, juvenile informed warning and juvenile prosecutorial diversion.

NOTES:

- (1) Targets will be based on that achieved in 2006 – 2007.
- (2) Target to be achieved by placing a particular focus on criminal damage to vehicles and dwellings.
- (3) Assaults include common assaults, aggravated assaults, assault occasioning actual bodily harm, wounding/grievous bodily harm and wounding/grievous bodily harm with intent (excluding assaults on police).
- (4) Targets will be based on that achieved in 2006-07, by focusing on detections for careless/dangerous driving, excess speed, driving whilst impaired through drink and/or drugs.
