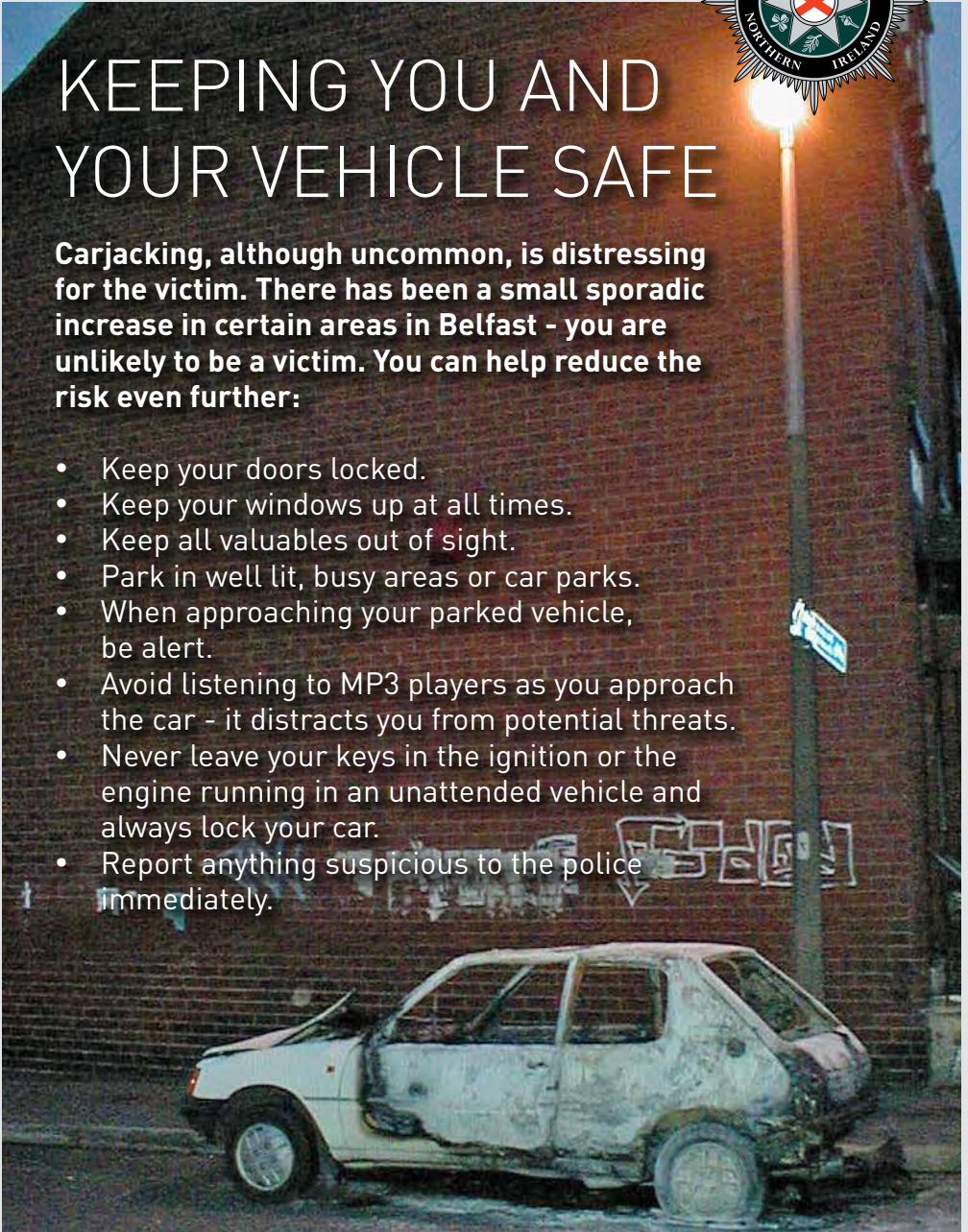




KEEPING YOU AND YOUR VEHICLE SAFE

Carjacking, although uncommon, is distressing for the victim. There has been a small sporadic increase in certain areas in Belfast - you are unlikely to be a victim. You can help reduce the risk even further:

- Keep your doors locked.
- Keep your windows up at all times.
- Keep all valuables out of sight.
- Park in well lit, busy areas or car parks.
- When approaching your parked vehicle, be alert.
- Avoid listening to MP3 players as you approach the car - it distracts you from potential threats.
- Never leave your keys in the ignition or the engine running in an unattended vehicle and always lock your car.
- Report anything suspicious to the police immediately.



Your Police Service will continue to do everything it can to prevent incidents of this type occurring, but you can assist us and keep yourself safer, by following the simple steps outlined.

People who Carjack vehicles can not only injure the car owner, but are unlikely to drive safely putting all of us at risk. The stolen vehicles are often burnt out creating further risk.
