<sup>1</sup>Any incident of threatening behaviour, violence, or abuse (psychological, physical, sexual, financial or emotional) by one family member against another or adults who are or have been intimate partners, regardless of gender, and whether a crime has occurred or not, will be recorded as domestic abuse.

<sup>2</sup>Domestic abuse motivated incidents cover all such occurrences, whether a crime has been committed or not. When using incident figures in conjunction with crime figures please note that hate motivated crimes are included in the incident figures, and that more than one crime may be recorded in a single incident.
