Question 2

Number of robberies/burglaries each day in east Belfast from January 1, 2009 until and including February 18, 2009. Please just put date and number of Robberies/burglaries beside each date.

Question 3

Number of robberies/burglaries each day in west Belfast from January 1, 2009 until and including February 18, 2009. Please put date and Number of robberies/burglaries beside each date.

Question 4

Number of robberies/burglaries each day in Fermanagh from January 1, 2009 until and including February 18, 2009. Please put date and Number of robberies/burglaries beside each date.

In most circumstances the Information Commissioner will not investigate a complaint unless an internal review procedure has been carried out, however the Commissioner has the option to investigate the matter at his discretion.
