Request and Answer:

This is to inform you that the Police Service of Northern Ireland has now completed its search for the information you requested. The decision has been taken to disclose the located information to you in full.

Question - The number of officers who have been signed out of their probation, within B District (South & East Belfast) since January 2008 to today inclusive. I would be grateful that this is broken down into a monthly return if possible.

Answer - Since January 2008, there has been a total of 40 officers signed out of their probation within B District.

If you are dissatisfied in any way with the handling of your request, you have the right to request a review. If following an internal review, carried out by an independent decision maker, you were to remain dissatisfied in any way with the handling of the request you may make a complaint, under Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act, to the Information Commissioner's Office and ask that they investigate whether the PSNI has complied with the terms of the Freedom of Information Act. You can write to the Information Commissioner at Information Commissioner's Office, Wycliffe House, Water Lane, Wilmslow, Cheshire, SK9 5AF. In most circumstances the Information Commissioner will not investigate a complaint unless an internal review procedure has been carried out, however the Commissioner has the option to investigate the matter at his discretion.
