Request and Answer:

Question 1

Can the PSNI list the number of incidents which they have responded to in relation to disturbance / breaches of public order at the interface areas at Bryson Street, Belfast and Mountpottinger Road, Belfast from April 2008 to date?

Answer

I can advise that since April 2008 police were called to 121 incidents in the interface areas mentioned in your request, of which 47 were disturbances/breaches of public order.

Question 2

Can the PSNI detail the approximate cost of the above?

Answer

The approximate cost of policing these incidents was £15,500.

It should be noted that this information has been retrieved from operational databases and has not been validated.

If following an internal review, carried out by an independent decision maker, you were to remain dissatisfied in any way with the handling of the request you may make a complaint, under Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act, to the Information Commissioner's Office and ask that they investigate whether the PSNI has complied with the terms of the Freedom of Information Act. In most circumstances the Information Commissioner will not investigate a complaint unless an internal review procedure has been carried out, however the Commissioner has the option to investigate the matter at his discretion.
