Subject: Road Traffic Collisions in Fermanagh

Request and Answer:

This is to inform you that the Police Service of Northern Ireland has now completed its search for the information you requested and the answers to your questions are as follows:

Question 1

I would like to get figures on road traffic accidents in Fermanagh, broken down in terms of different towns/areas.

Answer

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 21 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 it has been decided to refuse access to the information you have requested in question 1. Section 21 of the Act provides that information which is reasonably accessible to the applicant by other means is exempt information.

Answer

Based on the road name provided by the police officer we have provided the number of collisions and resulting casualties for calendar year 2009 –

If following an internal review, carried out by an independent decision maker, you were to remain dissatisfied in any way with the handling of the request you may make a complaint, under Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act, to the Information Commissioner's Office and ask that they investigate whether the PSNI has complied with the terms of the Freedom of Information Act. You can write to the Information Commissioner at Information Commissioner's Office, Wycliffe House, Water Lane, Wilmslow, Cheshire, SK9 5AF. In most circumstances the Information Commissioner will not investigate a complaint unless an internal review procedure has been carried out, however the Commissioner has the option to investigate the matter at his discretion.
