Subject: Thefts at Construction Sites

Request and Answer:

I am writing to confirm that the Police Service of Northern Ireland has now completed its search for the information.

I have today decided to:

- disclose information in response to questions 1 and 3 in full.
- disclose information in response to question 2 subject to the deletion of information pursuant to the provisions of Sections 30 and 40 of the Freedom of Information 2000 (the Act);

Question 1

Could you please tell me the number of recorded thefts, security breaches and/ or incidents at construction sites in your police force area last 12 full months prior to the receipt of this email, specifically between December 2010-November 2011.

Answer

There were a total of 366 incidents of recorded crime where location information indicates the offence to have occurred at a building site.

Question 2

I would like a breakdown of incidents which have taken place and where they have happened (specific site addresses). Could you tell me what has been damaged or/ and stolen from the site.

I would like a detailed breakdown of the type of thefts, or incidents which have taken place (either proven or alleged) and any conviction that has taken place (if this is in your ability to expand).

Answer

Please see the table below which details recorded crime where location information indicates the offence to have occurred at a building site by town, county and crime type from 1st December 2010 to 30th November 2011.

Please Note: This information is taken from a live crime recording system and may be subject to

change.

I have decided not to release the specific addresses of the building sites where the incidents occurred or what has been damaged/stolen as this is low level data.

Section 17(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 requires the Police Service of Northern Ireland, when refusing to provide such information (because the information is exempt) to provide you the applicant with a notice which:

- (a) states that fact,
- (b) specifies the exemption in question and
- (c) states (if not otherwise apparent) why the exemption applies.

The exemption/s, as well as the factors the Department considered when deciding where the public interest lies, are listed below:

Section 40 (2) (a) and (b) by virtue of Section 40 (3) (a) (i) – Personal Information

Section 30 (1) (a) Investigations and Proceedings Conducted by Public Authorities

Section 40 Personal Information is a class-based exemption, therefore it is not necessary to evidence the harm caused by disclosure. The data protection rights of a third party would be breached by disclosure, therefore Section 40(2) is an Absolute exemption and a Public Interest Test is not necessary. This is so because personal data is governed by other law (The Data Protection Act 1998). All requests made under FOIA are applicant blind. A request must be treated as such and a public authority will always view any disclosure as into the public domain and not just to an individual.

Personal Data is regulated under the principles of the Data Protection Act 1998 and when information contains personal data about a third party it can only be released if disclosure would not breach any data protection principles.

Principle (1), that personal data is processed lawfully and fairly. Personal data of this nature is recorded and it must be treated in a highly confidential manner and any public disclosure would be unlawful if there is a breach of that law of confidentiality.

When a member of the public provides personal data i.e. the address of where the incident took place to the PSNI they will have an expectation that it will be treated fairly. The Service would be failing in its lawful duty were it to breach the Data Protection Act in order to furnish a disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Service has a duty to protect the personal data of all members of the public and any disclosure of this type of data into the public domain that relates or could be used to identify persons who have been involved in an incident will be unfair to any individual concerned. The public must have confidence that their information is treated sensitively and appropriately.

Section 30 is a class based qualified exemption and consideration must be given as to whether there is a public interest in disclosure.

Section 30 - Investigations

Public Interest Test

Factors Favouring Release

The release of such information would provide an insight into the police service and enable the public to have better understanding of the effectiveness of the police. The release of information could allow

the public to make informed decisions about police procedures and the money spent in this business area.

Factors Favouring Retention

To disclose information in respect of crimes at construction sites could reveal where current investigations are taking place. This could have detrimental effects which would impact ongoing investigations. This would in turn impact on police resources and lead to more crime being committed, placing individuals at risk and an investigation or the outcome of subsequent proceedings could be compromised.

Decision

On balance the requirement to withhold information relating to any criminal investigation and in conjunction with personal information by releasing the information relating to the addresses where incidents occurred and the property damaged or stolen which may affect the outcome of any court proceedings must take precedence. The Police Service is charged with enforcing the law, preventing and detecting crime and protecting the communities we serve. The PSNI will not divulge information if to do so would adversely affect any ongoing investigations. Whilst there is a public interest in the transparency of the law enforcement role of the Police Service and providing assurance that the PSNI is appropriately and effectively dealing with crime, there is a strong public interest in safeguarding the integrity of the police service

The details if released could be used in conjunction with other information which may already be in the public domain or which may become available in the future and could potentially compromise the health and safety of those involved.

In relation to question 3 the PSNI do not hold the information regarding convictions. This information is available from the Northern Ireland Court Service and a request can be made to their Freedom of Information office. I have provided a link to the website:

If you are dissatisfied in any way with the handling of your request, you have the right to request a review. You should do this as soon as possible, or in any case within two months of the date of issue of this letter. In the event that you require a review to be undertaken, you can do so by writing to the Head of Freedom of Information, PSNI Headquarters, 65 Knock Road, Belfast, BT5 6LE or by emailing foi@psni.pnn.police.uk.

If following an internal review, carried out by an independent decision maker, you were to remain dissatisfied in any way with the handling of the request you may make a complaint, under Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act, to the Information Commissioner's Office and ask that they investigate whether the PSNI has complied with the terms of the Freedom of Information Act. You can write to the Information Commissioner at Information Commissioner's Office, Wycliffe House, Water Lane, Wilmslow, Cheshire, SK9 5AF. In most circumstances the Information Commissioner will not investigate a complaint unless an internal review procedure has been carried out, however the Commissioner has the option to investigate the matter at his discretion.
