**Subject:** Crimes Committed By Persons Over 65 In Fermanagh

### Request and Answer:

This is to inform you that the Police Service of Northern Ireland (PSNI) has now completed its search for the information you requested and the answers to your questions are as follows.

### Question

How many crimes have been committed by persons over 65, i.e. pensioners, in Fermanagh, in the last three years?

Can you also give me information on the crimes that were committed by over 65 year olds, and the outcome following the police investigation?

### Answer

Please find below on pages numbered 1 and 2 details of persons over 65 arrested in Fermanagh in the last 3 years and the crimes associated with the arrest. It should be noted that we are unable to say if these persons were from Fermanagh.

With regard to the outcome following police investigation we are unable to provide this information as it has only recently become available on our crime recording systems (NICHE). The Public Prosecution Service may be best placed to assist you with an answer to this part and I have provided a link below to their website

If you are dissatisfied in any way with the handling of your request, you have the right to request a review. You should do this as soon as possible, or in any case within two months of the date of issue of this letter. If following an internal review, carried out by an independent decision maker, you were to remain dissatisfied in any way with the handling of the request you may make a complaint, under Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act, to the Information Commissioner's Office and ask that they investigate whether the PSNI has complied with the terms of the Freedom of Information Act. You can write to the Information Commissioner at Information Commissioner's Office, Wycliffe House, Water Lane, Wilmslow, Cheshire, SK9 5AF. In most circumstances the Information Commissioner will not investigate a complaint unless an internal review procedure has been carried out, however the Commissioner has the option to investigate the matter at his discretion.
