### Request and Answer:

#### Question

Please supply a monthly cost of the manpower costs over the twenty-four policing of the Alliance Party offices situated at Newtownards Road, Belfast and if the Alliance Party are paying towards this or is it coming out of Public (Ratepayers) funds.

#### Answer

Searches were conducted however these searches failed to locate any records or documents relevant to your request based on the information you have provided. Accordingly, I have determined that the Police Service of Northern Ireland does not hold the information to which you seek access.

While the total overall costs of Policing in the district are held the cost of policing the Alliance Party Offices cannot be analysed out from these costs.

For your information the table below shows a monthly breakdown of costs of policing the flag protests in B District. All costs are paid out of public funds.

If you are dissatisfied in any way with the handling of your request, you have the right to request a review. In most circumstances the Information Commissioner will not investigate a complaint unless an internal review procedure has been carried out, however the Commissioner has the option to investigate the matter at his discretion.
