### Request and Answer:

Can I please have the following information regarding the procurement of Audio Visual presentation services from any and all outside persons and companies? These products/services would involve the preparation of products combining audio visual evidence such as crime scene maps / crime scene photographs / CCTV and video evidence etc.

### Question 1

How much has the PSNI paid for products/services to persons or companies outside the PSNI for Audio Visual presentation products for serious crime for use by investigation teams and the judiciary in each of the financial years 2010/11, 2011/12, 2012/13, 2013/14 and 2014/15?

### Answer

This is to inform you that the Police Service of Northern Ireland has now completed its search for the information you requested. The decision has been taken to disclose the located information to you in full.

The following figures have been extracted from the PSNI finance system and detail the spend by Serious Crime on CCTV enhancement. The totals are as follows and exclude VAT.

In most circumstances the Information Commissioner will not investigate a complaint unless an internal review procedure has been carried out, however the Commissioner has the option to investigate the matter at his discretion.
