### Request and Answer:

#### Request 1

Please release all Memoranda of Understanding between the PSNI and the Charity Commission NI, from 2012 to present date.

#### Request 2

Please state (if any) the number of concerns reported by members of the Charity Commission or other public bodies in Northern Ireland, that may have originated from any proscribed groups, which the PSNI have assessed, or investigated from October 2017 to January 2018.

#### Clarification To Requester :

In Question 2 it refers to 'other public bodies', to assist the Record Owner could you please provide a list of the 'public bodies' that you are referring to.

#### Clarification From Requester:

I accept that "other public bodies" is too broad a term, and I appreciate the difficulty there might be in collating such an amount of information. For the purposes of clarification and expediency in concluding this request, please confine your search to the Charity Commission for Northern Ireland

#### Answer

I contacted the relevant Departments Crime Operations and Command Secretariat, who conducted searches which failed to locate any records or documents relevant to your request based on the information you have provided.

Accordingly, I have determined that the Police Service of Northern Ireland does not hold the information to which you seek access.

If you are dissatisfied in any way with the handling of your request, you have the right to request a review. If following an internal review, carried out by an independent decision maker, you were to remain dissatisfied in any way with the handling of the request you may make a complaint, under Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act, to the Information Commissioner's Office and ask that they investigate whether the PSNI has complied with the terms of the Freedom of Information Act. You can write to the Information Commissioner at Information Commissioner's Office, Wycliffe House, Water Lane, Wilmslow, Cheshire, SK9 5AF. In most circumstances the Information Commissioner will not investigate a complaint unless an internal review procedure has been carried out, however the Commissioner has the option to investigate the matter at his discretion.
