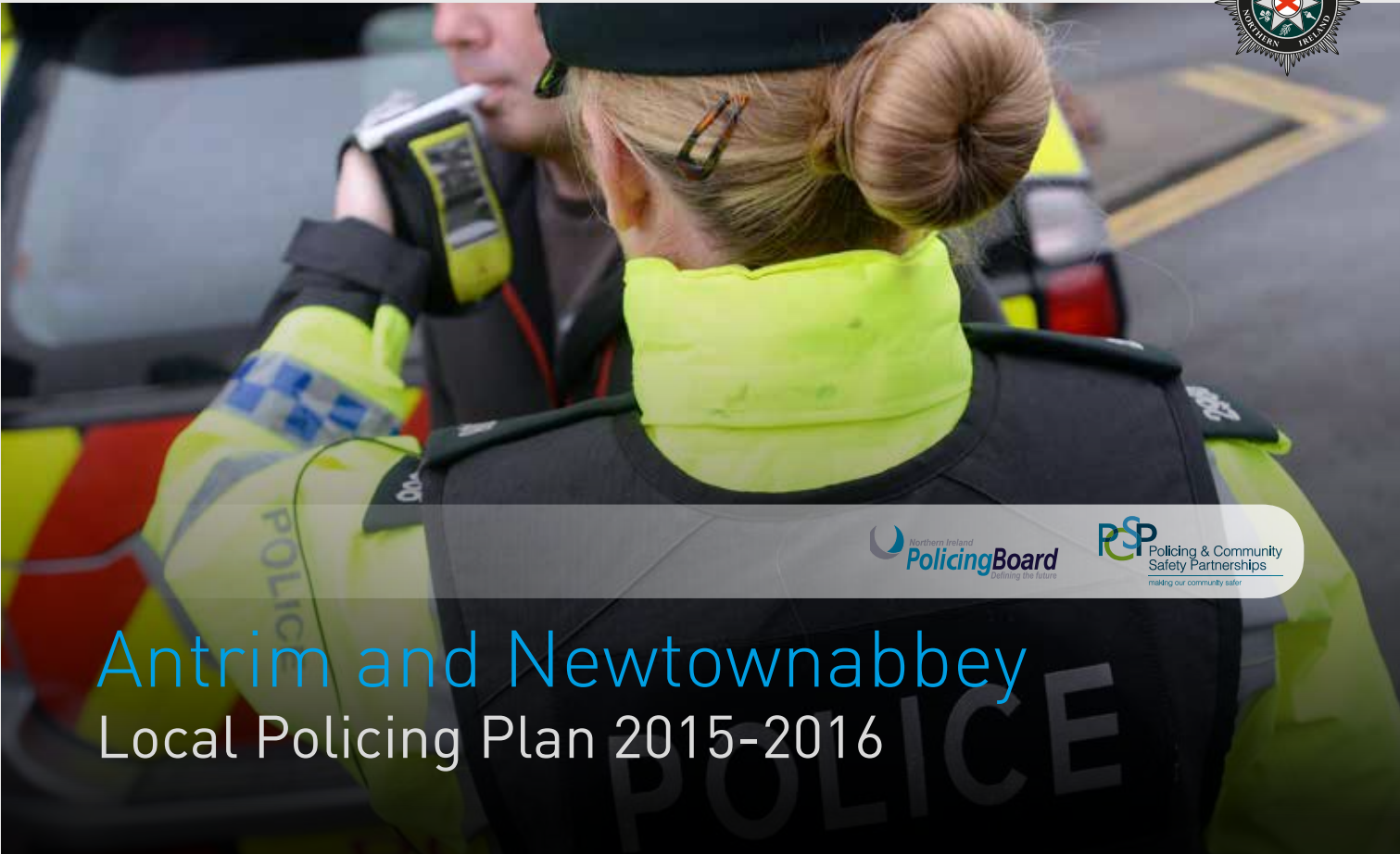

How we will measure our success against these issues:

Outcome	Indicator	Measure
Antisocial behaviour	Work with partners to reduce antisocial behaviour	To work with PCSPs and other partner agencies through direct involvement in Community Planning as a means by which to identify long-term objectives and actions to deal with antisocial behaviour.
Drugs and drug related criminality	Reducing the harm caused by drugs in local neighbourhoods	To continue to support local PCSPs and key stakeholder initiatives aimed at removing illegal drugs from the community and reducing the community harm caused by drugs through the following activities: Reporting the number of seizures, searches and outcome rates to demonstrate action taken.
Improved quality of service	Work with victims of crime to improve levels of confidence and to keep victims updated and informed on actions taken to investigate crime	To ensure that victims of crime are informed on actions taken by police to investigate the crime: To increase by 5% the number of victims currently receiving an update within 10 days on actions being taken to investigate crime

Outcome	Indicator	Measure
Improved service to vulnerable groups	Service provided to vulnerable groups	To work in partnership with PCSPs, and in particular Health and Social Care Trusts through direct involvement in Community Planning to reduce the number of persons reported missing and reduce the risk of harm to vulnerable missing persons. This will include bench marking the numbers and locations of persons reported missing from HSC establishments for 2015/16 in order to develop interagency plans to manage and reduce risk to those persons.
Burglary Reducing crime and keeping people safe	The number of burglaries	To reduce the number of burglaries: To reduce by 1% the number of burglaries in which older persons are victims. To increase by 2% points the outcome rate for burglary.
Hate crime Reduce crime and improve the service provided to vulnerable groups	The level of hate crime	An increase of 1% point in the outcome rate for sectarian and racist hate crime. To increase the number of reports of hate crime by encouraging victims to report.
Violent crime Reduce the level of violent crime and improve the service provided to vulnerable groups	The level of violent crime	To encourage increased reporting from victims of domestic abuse.
