Reducing criminal activities and harm caused by drugs in local neighbourhoods	Number of drug seizures	To continue to support local PCSPs and key stakeholder initiatives aimed at raising community awareness, removing illegal drugs from the community and reducing the community harm caused by drugs.
Reduced crime and antisocial behaviour	The number of domestic burglaries	To reduce by 1% the number of domestic burglaries.
Reduced road deaths and injuries	The number of people killed or seriously injured in road traffic collisions	<p>In partnership with other agencies, a reduction in the number of people killed in road collisions by 60% by 2020.</p> <p>In partnership with other agencies, a reduction in the number of people seriously injured in road collisions by 45% by 2020.</p>
Crime outcomes	The rate of crime outcomes achieved	To increase by 2% points the overall rate of crime outcomes achieved by 31 st March 2016 using a range of appropriate disposal methods.
