To report to the PCSP on initiatives taken in partnership with other agencies, to help achieve a reduction in the number of burglaries. This will include providing statistical evidence.
	Continue to improve our support for and interaction with victims of domestic abuse.	To report to the PCSP on initiatives taken in partnership with other agencies, to support victims of domestic abuse and increase outcome rates. This will include providing statistical evidence.
