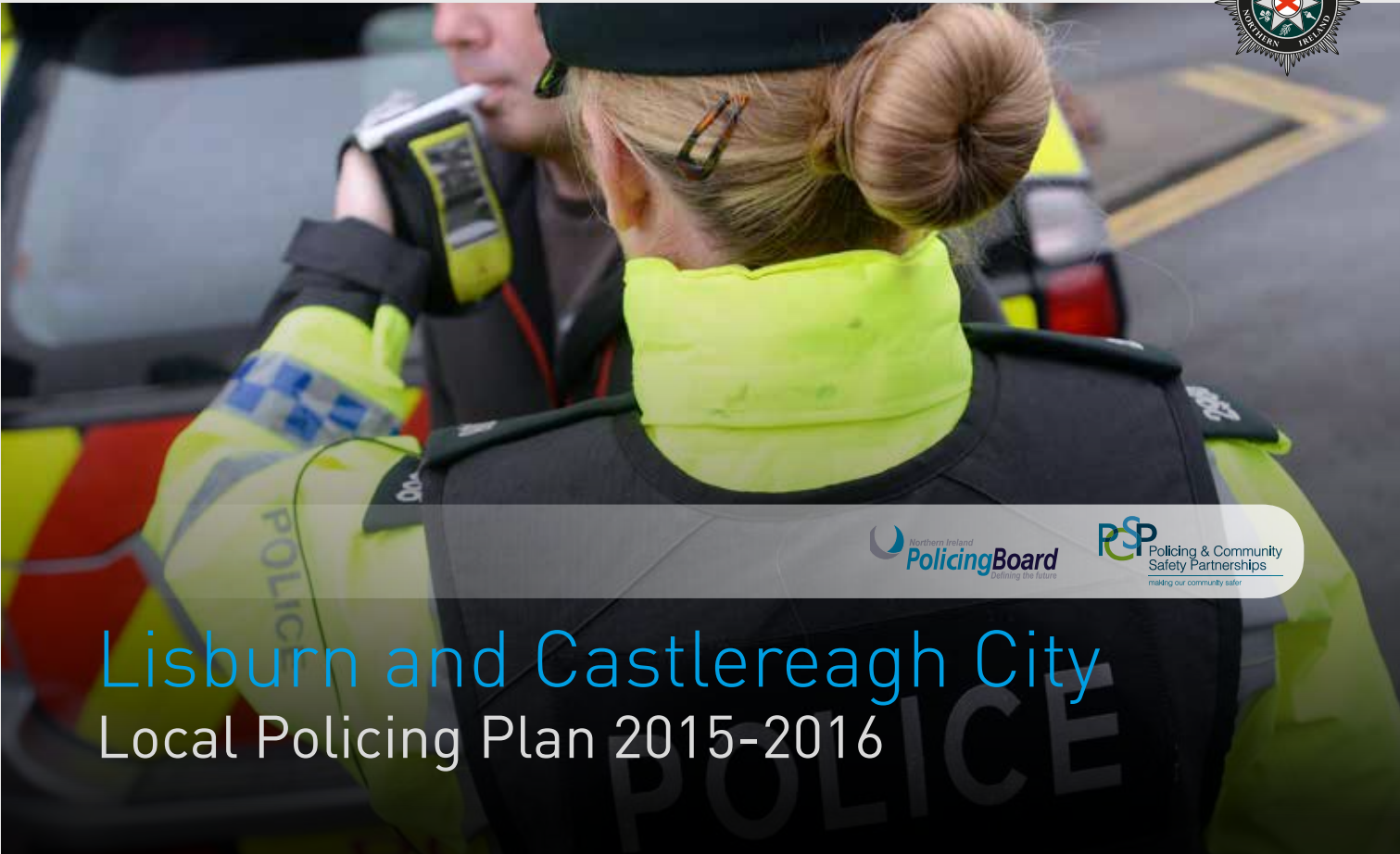

Improved quality of service.	The percentage of victims updated within 10 days on actions taken to investigate the crime.	To increase by 5% the number of victims currently receiving an update within 10 days. An increase of 2% points in the overall rate of outcomes achieved using a range of disposal methods.						
Improved quality of service.	The levels of violent crime where alcohol is a factor.	To continue to support local PCSPs, the community and key stakeholders through progression of initiatives aimed at understanding and reducing the harm caused by alcohol as a factor in violent crime.						
Reduction in the number of road deaths and injuries.	The number of people killed or seriously injured in road collisions. Reduced harm caused by drugs.	Reducing the harm caused by drugs.	<p>To increase by 2% points the outcome rate for drug offences.</p> <p>In partnership with PCSP develop and deliver an educational and awareness programme.</p>
Reduced crime and keeping people safe.	The number of domestic burglaries.	<p>To reduce the number of burglaries.</p> <p>To increase by 2% points the outcome rate for domestic burglary in which older persons are victims.</p>
Reduced level of violent crime and improvement in the service provided to vulnerable groups.	The level of violent crime with a domestic motivation.	An increase of 5% points in the outcome rate for crimes with a domestic motivation.
