Harm caused by crime and anti-social behaviour is reduced with a focus on protecting the most vulnerable, including repeat victims.	Address issues of anti-social behaviour, drug misuse, street drinking and vandalism, all of which increases the fear of crime.	Working with the community, we will report on locations we have identified as being hot spots for anti-social behaviour. We will tell you how we have worked in collaboration with the community and partner agencies to reduce the harm caused by crime and anti-social behaviour in those areas.
	Support the most vulnerable victims of crime and anti-social behaviour.	We will report on work we do to improve the quality of service delivery to vulnerable groups in collaboration with partners in relation to: • Hate crime; • Crimes against older people; • Children at risk; and • Domestic abuse.
People are Safe on the Roads.	Demonstrate a contribution to reduce the number of people killed or seriously injured on our roads through education and enforcement activity.	Report to PCSP on our education, prevention and enforcement activities around keeping people safe on our roads and demonstrate our contribution in reducing the number of: • People killed in road collisions; • People seriously injured in road collisions; • Children (aged 0-15) killed or seriously injured in road collisions; and • Young people (aged16-24) killed or seriously injured in road collisions.

Detecting Offences and Investigating Suspects: Theme 3: Reduction in Offending.

Identify and intervene with priority offenders.	Demonstrate an effective contribution to the integrated management of priority offenders in collaboration with partner agencies, in order to reduce reoffending.	Report to PCSP on how we are working with partner agencies to manage priority offenders to reduce reoffending and interventions with young people who are at risk of getting involved in crime.
Tackle serious and organised crime.	In collaboration with the PCSP and partner agencies, demonstrate an effective contribution to the implementation of initiatives and interventions to reduce the harm caused by drugs.	Report to PCSP on initiatives and interventions aimed at reducing the harm caused by drugs across Mid and East Antrim.
Tackle paramilitarism.	In collaboration with partner agencies, local communities and PCSP, demonstrate an effective contribution to reduce the negative impact of paramilitarism.	Report to PCSP on collaborative initiatives and interventions to reduce the negative impact of paramilitarism activity within our community.
