Subject: Police Staff working from home during Covid-19

Request and Answer:

Your request for information has now been considered. In respect of Section 1(1) (a) of the Act we can confirm that the Police Service of Northern Ireland does hold information to which your request relates. The decision has been taken to disclose the following.

Request

I would like to know how many Police Staff have been working from home during the Coronavirus pandemic.

Answer

It is not possible for the PSNI to answer this request, as each Department and/or District practises different working arrangements. In that some staff are working from home 5 days a week to others working 1, 2, 3 or 4 days a week. However we can advise that 5,132 laptops have been issued as of the 18th May 2021.

It should be noted that not all these devices have been issued for home working, as there are other reasons for being issued with a laptop device. Please also note that not all of the above devices have been issued due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

If you are dissatisfied in any way with the handling of your request, you have the right to request a review. You should do this as soon as possible or in any case within two months of the date of issue of this letter. If following an internal review, carried out by an independent decision maker, you were to remain dissatisfied in any way with the handling of the request you may make a complaint, under Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act, to the Information Commissioner's Office and ask that they investigate whether the PSNI has complied with the terms of the Freedom of Information Act. You

can write to the Information Commissioner at Information Commissioner's Office, Wycliffe House, Water Lane, Wilmslow, Cheshire, SK9 5AF. In most circumstances the Information Commissioner will not investigate a complaint unless an internal review procedure has been carried out, however the Commissioner has the option to investigate the matter at his discretion.
