I would like to know the amount of road traffic accidents that have occurred at Teal Rocks on the Portaferry Road, Newtownards, BT23 8GJ in the last 5 years.

Answer

Please see the tables below detailing collision history of injury road traffic collisions reported to the police for the area of Teal Rocks/Portaferry Road junction, Newtownards for the 5 year period 1st January 2016 to 31st December 2020.

Please note: these include collisions at or within 50 metres of the above junction. The statistics include those collisions which involve injury and have been reported to the PSNI. Statistics branch do not collect data on damage only collisions.

In most circumstances the Information Commissioner will not investigate a complaint unless an internal review procedure has been carried out, however the Commissioner has the option to investigate the matter at his discretion.
