

Attacks on Greencastle RUC Station, Shore Road between January 1970 and June 1976

Date and time of attack	Means of attack	Injuries to security force personnel or members of the public	Extent of the damage to the station and surrounding area
30 October 1970, 3:41am	Explosion	Slight injuries to RUC personnel.	Extensive damage.
3 October 1971, 9:31pm	Explosion	No injuries recorded.	Fairly extensive damage to wall of station. Windows were smashed in station and in several nearby buildings.
26 November 1971, 11:45pm	Explosion	No injuries recorded.	The blast blew a large hole in the ground, blew in the front door, smashed all the front windows in the building, damaged the roof and caused some interior damage.
8 August 1973, 12:21am	Missiles thrown at station	RUC officer stuck on head with a brick, requiring hospital treatment.	No damage recorded.
28 August 1973, 07:45am	One shot fired at police patrol car outside station.	No injuries.	No damage recorded.
16 October 1973, 23:25pm	3 shots fired at station.	No injuries.	No damage recorded.
24 November 1973, 8:35pm	Explosive device fired at station followed by 7 or 8 shots.	No injuries.	No damage.
