1. Policy Statement

Specialist assets (personnel and equipment) will be used to support policing operations and mitigate threat and risks to the public, police officers and police staff, this will include:

- Serious, Organised and Volume Crime;
- Matters affecting National Security;
- Firearms Operations; and
- Any other issues requiring specialist knowledge or support.

Police Service of Northern Ireland (PSNI) is committed to the lawful and properly controlled use of specialist/technical solutions that benefit public safety outcomes. These benefits can include the acquisition of otherwise unobtainable evidence and the use of tactics or technical equipment rather than people to deliver efficiencies and reduce risk.

PSNI will ensure that staff are effectively trained, accredited and equipped to carry out their respective specialist roles.

PSNI will engage with partners to deliver enhanced national and local resilience in the areas of Specialist Support.

Compliance with relevant legislation and applicable code(s) will ensure that the use of Specialist Support to investigations is lawful, proportionate and fully justifiable.
