## Request and Answer:

Your request for information has now been considered. In respect of Section 1(1)(a) of the Act I can confirm that the Police Service of Northern Ireland does hold information to which your request relates. The decision has been taken to disclose the following.

## Request

I would please like to know the number of reports of domestic abuse-related incidents and domestic abuse-related offences (also known as domestic violence) perpetrated by police employees.

To clarify, I am not seeking all reports about domestic abuse, only those where a police employee is an alleged perpetrator.

Justifications for disclosure: similar information has been released for 2015-2017 under FOI No. F-2018-01041. I'm only seeking similar information for a different time period (2018/19/20/21).

It should be noted that due to low levels of data the breakdown of ranks are on a separate tab and are not linked in any way to the rest of the data.

investigate whether the PSNI has complied with the terms of the Freedom of Information Act. In most circumstances the Information Commissioner will not investigate a complaint unless an internal review procedure has been carried out, however the Commissioner has the option to investigate the matter at his discretion.
