#### Request and Answer:

Your request for information has now been considered. In respect of Section 1(1)(a) of the Act I can confirm that the Police Service of Northern Ireland does hold information to which your request relates. The decision has been taken to disclose the following.

## Request 1

From 1st April 2016 to 30th April 2021 how many members of the PSNI have been disciplined for using a police vehicle contrary to the Road Traffic NI Order, PSNI policies, directives or regulations?

#### **Answer**

Between 1<sup>st</sup> April 2016 and 30<sup>th</sup> April 2021 a total of 25 officers have been disciplined for using a police vehicle contrary to the Road Traffic NI Order or PSNI policies, directives and regulations.

You can write to the Information Commissioner at Information Commissioner's Office, Wycliffe House, Water Lane, Wilmslow, Cheshire, SK9 5AF. In most circumstances the Information Commissioner will not investigate a complaint unless an internal review procedure has been carried out, however the Commissioner has the option to investigate the matter at his discretion.
