Answer to Request 1 (a and b)

Table 1 shows the number of times that handcuffing, limb restraints and unarmed physical tactics were used on members of the public during April 2018 to March 2019 and April 2019 to March 2020 by ethnicity.

Unarmed physical tactics include physical restraint, take downs, pressure points, blocks/strikes and other improvised tactics. If more than one type of unarmed physical tactic was used on the same individual, each type of force will be counted in Table 1. For example, if an officer physically restrained and took down an individual, these will both be counted. Likewise, if an individual was handcuffed and had limb restraints applied, both of these uses of force will be recorded below. Therefore the figures in Table 1 are a count of the total number of times restraint techniques were used by officers and are not a count of the number of persons on whom force was used.
