Subject: Road Contraventions in Carrickfergus - 20/10/21 - 31/08/22

Request and Answer:

Your request for information has now been considered. In respect of Section 1(1)(a) of the Act we can confirm that the Police Service of Northern Ireland does hold information to which your request relates. The decision has been taken to disclose the following.

Request 1

I wish to know how many cautions or prosecutions for contravention of the pedestrian areas in North Street and West Street Carrickfergus by motorists not complying with the restriction on vehicles in the pedestrian area between 19th October 2021 and 31st August 2022?

Request 2

The contravention of a no right turn at the end of North Street into West Street between 19th October 2021 and 31st August 2022?

Answers

A search of the PSNI databases indicates that there were no detections (therefore no cautions or prosecutions) for contravention of the pedestrian areas in North Street and West Street Carrickfergus by motorists not complying with the restriction on vehicles in the pedestrian area or the contravention of a no right turn at the end of North Street into West Street, between 19th October 2021 and 31st August 2022.

Please note:

- 1. The search included detections which were dealt with by either a Fixed Penalty Notice or referral for prosecution.
- 2. The information is based on a free text search of the location field therefore any information retrieved is dependent on it being input accurately by the officer e.g. any typos or deviations in spelling of road names may result in a record not being returned.
- 3. The figures are provisional and subject to amendment.

If you are dissatisfied in any way with the handling of your request, you have the right to request a

If, following an Internal Review carried out by an independent decision maker, you remain dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you may make a complaint to the Information Commissioner's Office, under Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act, and ask that they investigate whether the PSNI has complied with the terms of the Freedom of Information Act.
