In respect of Section 1(1)(a) of the Act we can confirm that the Police Service of Northern Ireland does not hold information in relation to your requests. Enquiries made in relation to your request failed to locate any records or documents relevant to your request based on the information you have provided.

Complaints against the Police Service of Northern Ireland are made to the Police Ombudsman for Northern Ireland, and statistics relating to the number of complaints are provided to the Police Service on a monthly basis. Information relating to the time period 9 September 2022 and 19 September 2022 has not yet been received.

Accordingly, I have determined that the Police Service of Northern Ireland does not hold the information to which you seek access.
