Your request for information has now been considered. In respect of Section 1(1)(a) of the Act I can confirm that the Police Service of Northern Ireland does hold information to which your request relates. The decision has been taken to disclose the following.

Request

I am currently undertaking research into the area of general purpose police dog deployment and would be grateful if you would please provide the following: Could you please advise if it is currently mandatory within your force for officers deploying general purpose police dogs, to wear and / or activate Body Worn Video?

I would appreciate an electronic response by email, along with any supporting documentation such as force guidelines if applicable.

Answer

All PSNI dog handlers are trained in Body Worn Video (BWV) and deploy with it on each duty. The handlers follow PSNI policy in relation to activation of BWV when at an incident or deploying their police dog.

If you are dissatisfied in any way with the handling of your request, you have the right to request a

If following an internal review, carried out by an independent decision maker, you were to remain dissatisfied in any way with the handling of the request you may make a complaint, under Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act, to the Information Commissioner's Office and ask that they investigate whether the PSNI has complied with the terms of the Freedom of Information Act. In most circumstances the Information Commissioner will not investigate a complaint unless an internal review procedure has been carried out, however the Commissioner has the option to investigate the matter at his discretion.
