Request and Answer:

Your request for information has now been considered. In respect of Section 1(1)(a) of the Act we can confirm that the Police Service of Northern Ireland (PSNI) does hold the information to which your request relates. The decision has been taken to disclose the following.

From March 2020 until September 2021, please could you advise:

Request 1

How many police officers and members of staff were attached to PSNI Professional Standards Discipline Branch?

Answer

During the period March 2020 to September 2021 a total of 18 police officers and a total of 19 police support staff were attached to PSNI Professional Standards Discipline Branch.

Request 2

Of these, how many worked remotely at any stage during the period March 2020 to September 2021?

By working remotely, I mean away from their normal place of work, including working from home.

Answer

Of the total provided above, a total of 16 police officers and a total of 17 police support staff attached to PSNI Professional Standards Discipline Branch worked remotely at some stage during the requested time period.

In most circumstances, the Information Commissioner will not investigate a complaint unless an internal review procedure has been carried out however, the Commissioner has the option to investigate the matter at their discretion.
