#### **Request 1**

Confirm how many officers within your Constabulary identify under the Equality Act 2010 as a transexual undergoing transition, transgender, or moving from birth sex to a preferred gender?

### **Request 2**

How many officers who identify as transexual officers participated in searches of members of the public for the period Jan 2022 – November 2022.

#### **Request 3**

How many police officers identify as a Transwomen - a man moving from birth sex to female.

## **Request 4**

How many police officers identify as a Transman - a woman moving from birth sex to male.

## **Request 5**

How many police officers identify as Non-binary: a woman moving from birth sex to Non-binary.

## **Request 6**

How many police officers identify as Non-binary: a man moving from birth sex to Non-binary.

#### Answer

Your request for information has now been considered. In respect of Section 1(1)(a) of the Act we can confirm that the Police Service of Northern Ireland (PSNI) does not hold information in relation to your requests. Enquiries made in relation to your request failed to locate any records or documents relevant to your request.

The information requested is not available as transgender/non-binary is not currently monitored by the Police Service of Northern Ireland.

Accordingly, we have determined that the Police Service of Northern Ireland does not hold the information to which you seek access.
