The Police Service of Northern Ireland is committed to protecting the personal security of people and the physical security of the Police Estate.

1. Policy Statement

The Police Service of Northern Ireland (PSNI) will:

- Provide advice to individuals who are assessed to be at risk and work with statutory partners to protect those subject to threats or intimidation;
- Ensure that necessary and proportionate physical security measures are in place and operating effectively to protect the Police Estate, people using the estate and our assets;
- Offer security advice to locations and premises across Northern Ireland at risk from terrorism;
- Liaise with the Home Office National Counter Terrorism Office and the Centre for the Protection of the National Infrastructure;
- Implement vetting procedures that protect our assets and data from persons and organisations, both internal and external, that may seek to cause harm. This provides an appropriate level of assurance as to the trustworthiness, integrity and reliability of all staff and non-police personnel working within the Police Estate; and

- Review physical and personal security requirements to mitigate against developing threats to maintain confidence in the ability of the PSNI to Keep People Safe.
